This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: We have read the poem What is Pink by Christina Rossetti. The children have enjoying spotting the questions marks in the poem and performing it, with expression. We have also had a go at writing our own poems with a focus on choosing different verbs to create imagery.

Maths: We started the week by comparing numbers and then ordering numbers in ascending and descending order. We have also completed number sequences by counting in 2s, 5, and 10s.

Science: We have been exploring micro-habitats by looking under logs, rocks, in piles of leaves and within the grass. Using careful observations, the children noticed the minibeasts that live there.

History: We compared the experiences of two explorers, Ibn Battuta and George Vancouver, and why they are both important.
