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Good Afternoon,

This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: We have been busy planning our own Wild Robot story based on what we know about the character. We have also looked at sentences in the simple past tense and the past progressive tense.

Maths: We have been remembering the names of 2d and 3d shapes and looking at how to spell them correctly too. We have also investigated the number of sides and vertices on different polygons and have tried to draw them accurately using a ruler.

D.T: The children have had a first try at building their wheeled vehicles using fixed axles. They used this first attempt to work out what works and what doesn't, adapting as they went along.

Geography: We have started our new topic on mapping by having a go at drawing a map of the school. We then looked at an actual map of the school and the surrounding area on Digimaps and identified what some of the symbols represented. We also talked about the difference between an aerial view and eye-level view of the same thing.
