This week in Kingfisher Class...

English/RE: We started our unit of work on why light is an important symbol in religions by exploring different light sources and how light made us feel. The children then looked at the importance of light in the festivals of Diwali and Hannukah.

PSHRE: We have continued to look at 'What Makes a Good Friend?' by discussing how a friend should behave and make us feel, what to do if we fall out with a friend and how to seek help if a friendship is making us unhappy.

Maths: We practised our addition and subtraction skills when playing dice games.
