This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: The children have been writing a variety of sentences and recapping conjunctions and adjectives.

Maths: We have looked at place value this week. We practised reading numbers such as 38 and worked out how many tens and ones are needed to make this two-digit number. We have used different concrete materials to represent each number.

Science: This week, we have focused on learning about 'Animals and Their Habitats'. We began by sorting pictures into categories: alive, used to be alive and never been alive. We then explored why birds live in our Forest School area, investigated microhabitats in the Forest School area and created food chains.

PE: We have been practising ball skills. We used our feet to keep a ball under control using small movements.

Notices and messages:

1. Your child will have been given a reading book this week to bring home. It is really important that they continue to practise their reading skills regularly to improve fluency. Our reading days are Tuesdays and Fridays. Children on Accelerated Reader will need to have understood what they have read in order to successfully quiz so it is a good idea to read each book a few times.
2. Well done to all the children for accessing Numbots this week. The aim is for 25 minutes a week.
