## This week in Kingfisher Class...

**English:** We have been identifying adjectives in the story of Handa's Surprise and then generating some new adjectives of our own to describe the fruit in different ways.

**Maths:** We started the week by finding the missing number on number lines up to 100. We then used symbols (greater than, less than and equal to) to compare objects and numbers. We also ordered numbers in ascending and descending order and ended the week by counting in 2s, 3s and 10s.

**Computing (PSHRE link):** We learnt how to use key words when researching things using a search engine. We then moved onto voice activated searches and used this to look for specific information. We also discussed who this technology might benefit and the limitations of it.

1. Reading sessions take place in school twice a week. Please continue to listen to your child read regularly at home to give them the best possible opportunities for reading with fluency and understanding.
