This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: We have started a new poetry unit this week. We began by reading the poem, '*What is Pink?*' by Christina Rossetti, and discussed some of the imagery portrayed in the poem. We then focused on performing the poem paying close attention to expression, tone, pace and volume.

Maths: We started the week by adding together two-digit numbers by exchanging e.g. $28 + 16$. We noticed how you can make a new 10 and used the base 10 equipment to model the exchange. We then used the greater than, less than and equal to symbols to compare number sentences and solved missing number problems.

P.E: We have added some new creatures to our dance in the enchanted garden. We have considered the dynamics of our movements so that they represent the animals well.

PSHRE: This week is Anti-Bullying Week. We have discussed what constitutes bullying and used drama to explore the difference between accidental behaviour and behaviour that is on purpose. We then looked at the difference between friendly joking, teasing and bullying. The children discussed what they would do if a person was unkind to them and who they can go to for help.
