## This week in Kingfisher Class...

**English:** We looked again at the poem '*What is Pink?*' and identified the verbs. We chatted about what impact these verbs have on the dynamics of the poem. Then we changed the verbs to create a new mood and discussed the impact of this.

**Maths:** We have started our new unit of work on money and have looked closely at different coins and added up to different amounts. It would be helpful if your child has the opportunity at home to look at and handle real money and practise adding different coins together. Later in the term, we will be working out change.

**History:** We have started a new topic learning about Explorers. We asked the question 'Why do people explore?' Then we shared some photos of explorers and placed them on a timeline. The first explorer we learnt about was Ibn Battuta. We looked at where he travelled, why he chose to travel and the experiences he had.
