This week in Kingfisher Class...

Nativity: It has been a very busy week of rehearsals in Kingfisher class. We have practised in the school hall with Butterfly Class and Owl Class and had a full dress rehearsal on Friday.

English: This week, we have written our own versions of *What is Pink?* and performed this in groups. We thought about volume, tone, actions we could use and how we might engage with the audience.

Maths: We have continued to look at money and have compared different amounts using greater than, less than and equals to symbols. We have chosen coins and notes to make a range of totals and have made the same total in different ways.

History: The children have learnt about Norfolk-born explorer, George Vancouver.

Notices and messages:
