This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: We have been reading and writing sentences with a question mark. We have also been learning how to change verbs from the present tense to the past tense. On Friday, we used the past tense to write a recount of our visit to Norwich Castle.

Maths: We started the week by learning how to divide (share equally) in two. We linked this to our knowledge of the 2x table. We then looked at doubling and halving numbers using Base 10 to exchange a ten for ten ones where necessary.

History: We have continued to learn about Norwich Castle. Before our trip, we found out who lived in the castle and what it was like. We also looked at how the castle was used as a gaol and prison for over 500 years.

Class trip to Norwich Castle: We had an amazing day at Norwich Castle yesterday! We helped various characters complete jobs in the Chapel, the Castle kitchens, the Great Hall and the King's chamber, ready for the visiting monarch. After lunch, we looked at Norwich from the battlements and then explored the amazing animals in the Natural History Gallery.
