This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: We have been learning about suffixes, specifically *er* and *ly*. This has tied in with our morning spellings as we have found out the rules when adding endings to root words. We have used this information to change adjectives to adverbs by adding *ly* and describing how the main characters in our story move.

Maths: We started the week by securing our understanding of odd and even numbers. We then looked at multiplying and dividing a number by 10 and 5. We noted patterns in both times tables and how we could identify a multiple of 10 and a multiple of 5.

History: We looked at photos from our trip to Norwich Castle last week and wrote sentences to describe what the castle is used for now. Later in the week, we completed a hot task to demonstrate what we had learnt.

Science: We have started our new unit of work on *Everyday Materials* by recapping prior learning to identify different materials, their uses and properties.
