**Homework:** (15 minutes of TTRS a week, 15 minutes of reading daily)



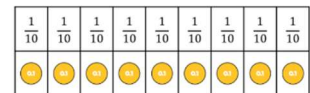
25% of the class completed some minutes of TTRS outside of our session in school this week.

### Learning this week:

In English, We continued our poetry writing and played some writing games: firstly, 'Dabble' - listening to a poem and then responding by making lists of interesting words, drawing or ideas - anything that came to mind when listening to the poem. We then played 'Spark Line' again, listening to a poem but this time, writing our own poem 'sparked' from a line or image in the poem we heard. The children came up with some interesting and original compositions.

In Maths We finished our pure fractions unit and are now using this knowledge to help us compare decimals and fractions for example:



Complete the sentences to describe the number.

The fraction represented is  $\frac{9}{10}$

The decimal represented is 0.9

The fraction  $\frac{9}{10}$  is equivalent to the decimal 0.9

This week in Computing, we used microbits and wrote some code using inputs and variables. We programmed the microbits to make a game of 'Hot Potato' which we enjoyed playing in the playground.

In Art we looked at complementary and harmonious colours. We looked at examples of Van Gogh's work where he used these and thought about how they affected the mood and atmosphere of the painting. We also learned about how depth can be shown using foreground, middle ground and background.
