## This week in Kingfisher Class...

**English:** We have been learning how to set out and write instructions. We have written some instructions to show how we made our moving vehicles last week.

**Maths:** We started the week by using the four operations to solve problems that involved measure. We then started our new unit of work on fractions by looking at parts and whole, equal groupings, and how to recognise and find a half. We have learnt key vocabulary linked to this (numerator and denominator).

**Geography:** Our focus for this week was map work. We recapped the names of the 7 continents and 5 oceans and learnt the difference between a map and a plan. We then looked at a map of Norwich and moved from one landmark to another using a key and compass points. The children ended the week by walking around the back playground and creating a map and key of a familiar place.
