This week in Kingfisher Class...

It was lovely to welcome the children back to school this week. They have settled in well to the new term and are a joy to be with.

English: We started the week by finishing writing our instructions on how to make a wheeled vehicle.

Maths: We have recognised a quarter and a third of different shapes by ensuring the parts were all equal first. We then worked really hard on using bar models to work out fractions of different amounts. We even managed to have a go at working out the whole number based on a fraction given to us (e.g. $\frac{1}{4}$ of ? is 4).

RE: We started our new RE unit of work on '*How do Christians show they belong to their faith family?*'. The children began by reflecting on groups and clubs they belonged to and how they showed and felt they belonged. We also all decided we belonged to our families and Hingham Primary School. Some of us also belonged to After School Club and Breakfast Club. We then looked at why it was important for Christians to go to church on Sundays and why the church was an important aspect of belonging.

This afternoon, Kingfisher Class walked to St Andrew's Church in Hingham for a talk given by Reverend Tori and Reverend Peter on how Christians show they belong to their faith family. The children were shown artefacts that were used in Holy Communion and infant christenings. They also gained an understanding of how religious symbols were used to show belonging. It was wonderful to visit our beautiful local church where the topic was brought to life.
