It has been another busy week of learning here in Badger Class. We have started lots of lovely new things.

Homework: (Expectations = 15 minutes of TTRS a week, 15 minutes of reading daily)

Learning this week:

Maths: We have moved on to revisiting the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We challenged ourself to imagine the parts of the 3D shapes that we cannot see in drawings and still be able to describe them in terms of faces, edges and vertices.

English: We are starting to plan and writ a class murder mystery based on 'The Case of the Drowned Pearl' by Robin Stevens. So far, we have worked on introducing our two main characters (the 'detectives'), setting the scene and discovering the crime. Why not ask your children to tell you what crime has been committed and describe the clues and who they think the murderer is going to be.

Geography: Before we get launched fully into some new learning, we have been revisiting some terms that we use a lot in Geography: human and physical features. We remembered what the difference between these is and identified some different examples of each. Ask your child to tell you the difference between a river and a canal explaining why one is a physical feature and the other a human feature.

Art: We have started our unit by looking at our focus artist, Betty Woodman. We looked at some examples of her pots and discussed what we thought they told us about her and the things that might influence her.

RE: We looked at some examples of music that have been written specifically to be played in church. We then used 'Chrome Music Lab' to create our own angelic music.
