**Homework:** (Expectations = 15 minutes of TTRS a week, 15 minutes of reading daily)



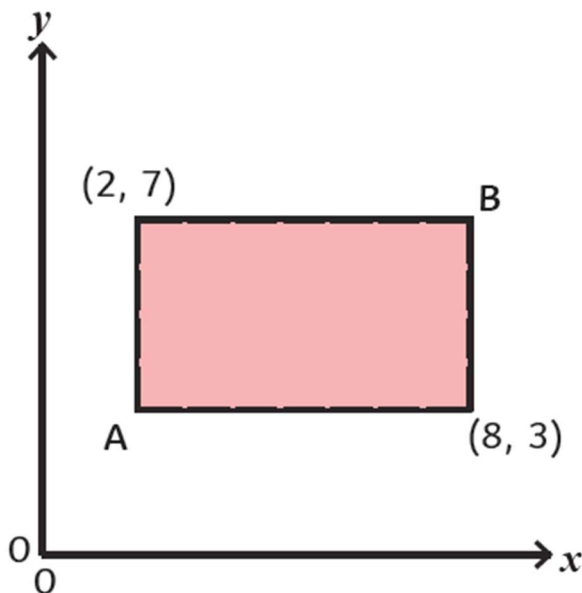
32% of the class completed some TTRS outside of school

### Learning this week:

**Maths:** This week we have started to look at position and direction. We have been using co-ordinates to play games like battleships and solve problems like the example below:



A rectangle has been drawn on a coordinate grid. Two vertices are labelled. Find the coordinates of vertices A and B.

**English:** We have finished writing our class murder mystery. Why not ask your child who it was that killed Silas Vane! Over the next fortnight, we will be starting work on our own individual murder mysteries, planning and writing them a little bit at a time. It might be helpful to ask your child to start thinking of the basic ingredients they are going to use for their stories.
