This week in Kingfisher Class...

Maths: We have been learning to tell the time to the hour and to every 5 minutes. The children have used analogue clocks to understand these concepts.

English/Science: At the start of the week, we tried to sort out the things that humans need to survive and discussed the difference between *needs* and *wants*. The children used great oracy skills to challenge each other in a discussion on this topic. We then looked at what our pets need to survive and used drama to explore how we can best look after them. We wrote clear instructions based on this and advice from the RSPCA. At the end of the week, we looked at the stages in a human life cycle and wrote about the differences between each.

Your child may have told you about our special visitors in Kingfisher Class who arrived a few weeks ago. Our caterpillars have all formed chrysalides now and we have transferred them into nets. We wait with bated breath to see our Painted Lady butterflies emerge!
