18% of the class completed some TTRS minutes outside of school

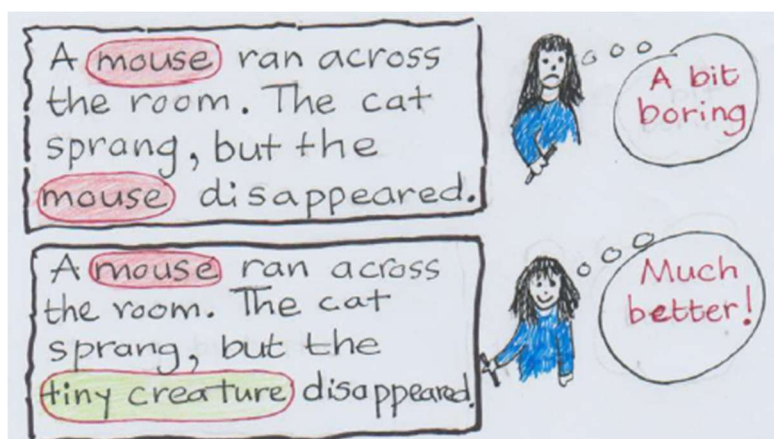

### Learning this week:

English: We spent some time looking at how we can make sentences more interesting in ways that don't involve adding extra descriptive words. We realised that just by carefully choosing the nouns which we used, we could make our writing more accurate and get it to say exactly what we wanted.
