This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: In the mornings, we have worked on identifying nouns, verbs and adjectives. We have also tried to write open-ended questions in the present tense for our new teacher and remembered to use the correct punctuation mark.

Maths: We have continued to find out about pictograms this week and have interpreted pictograms where one symbol represents 2, 5 or 10.

PSHRE: This week, we start a new unit of work where we think about how to keep ourselves safe. At the start of the week, we thought about the different things that we could do to help prevent a fire. On Tuesday, we were lucky enough to have a visit from the Fire Service who gave us some more ideas, such as not charging devices overnight and checking your smoke detector every Tuesday. Later in the week, we learnt how to be safe in water by floating on our backs if we got into difficulties. We then looked at different types of touch and listed ones that made us feel comfortable and ones that did not. Next, we explored how comfortable we felt with people in our personal space and discussed how we could let them know how we felt.
