This week in Kingfisher Class...

English: We have spent time over the past few weeks spelling words with suffixes, such as copy = copying / copied. We have noticed when we drop the y and add an i. We have also been revising different punctuation marks by filling them in in sentences.

Maths: We have been recapping some of the learning that we have covered over the year so far and revisiting any learning that was tricky for us to answer in the maths assessments. We started by looking at an online game called Daily 10, which the children enjoyed and may wish to use at home over the summer, starting at Level 1. [Daily 10 - Mental Maths Challenge - Topmarks](#)
Towards the end of the week, we carried on looking at pictograms where a symbol represented 2, 5 or 10. The children had to read and understand the data before answering questions on them.

PSHRE: We discussed road safety at the start of the week. We also spent time thinking about our emotional safety using a resource called Zones of Regulation. Each child has made their own Zones chart to encourage emotional literacy and strategies for becoming more independent in managing their own emotions.
